WHEN GOD SAID, STOP **PRAYING**

You might think that this subject is a bit unusual, but I hope it does not prove to be so. I think that it is absolutely necessary to preface this lesson with several readings from the Bible which deal with "the importance and essentiality of prayer..." (Rom. 12:8). Jesus said that men ought to always pray. (Luké 18:1) Paul told Timothy, "I will therefore that men pray everywhere, lifting up holy hands.." (I Tim. 2:8)

MEN OF GOD HAVE ALWAYS BEEN **ALTAR BUILDERS.** Before he built a house for his family or even a shed for his cattle, Noah built an altar. What I am trying to get you to see is that this is not a lesson against prayer. Prayer is too important and much to neglected to teach against it. But there are times when God says, STOP PRAYING.

Read Joshua 7:6-10. The setting of the story is that Joshua and the Israelites took the city of Jericho with God's help. Now they were to go against it. Spies were sent and they reported that the city was weak. Israel fled retreating disorderly, and Joshua knew something was wrong; the Lord had left them, so he prayed to God. The Lord said, "Get thee up" (STOP PRAY-ING), and in verse 11 we learn that THERE IS ŚIN IN THE CAMP. When the Lord told Joshua to STOP PRAYING, he was not saying that prayer was not important, but He was saying there was something to be done that took prece-RADIO PROGRAM dence over praying. Joshua could have prayed Sunday at 2:30 pm forever, but until sin was removed, God was not with them. Achan was stoned (who had sinned) by taking spoils from was stoned (who had

sinned by taking spoils from Jericho): sin was removed and Israel took the city. OBEDIENCE WAS OVER PRAYER.

WHEN LIFE IS NOT CONSISTENT WITH PRAYERS, we need to stop praying, correct the situation. Too often we pray to God, but do not live the way we pray. We ask God to feed the hungry and we close our purses to the needy. We ask God to comfort the weary, but we refuse to WEEP with those who weep. Read
