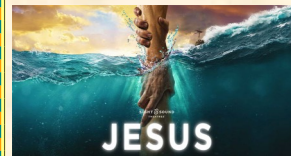
THE NAME THAT SAVES

IS THERE ANYTHING IN A NAME?

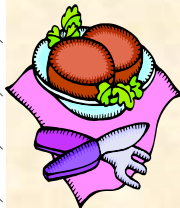
